Over 70 fact-checking organisations from 75 countries have joined forces to collect and debunk misinformation circulating in their regions. This collaborative effort provides digital media users with a consultation tool to swiftly identify and verify the authenticity of content, aiding in the detection of fake news. Additionally, the platform serves as a valuable resource for journalists, scientists, and academics to analyse the disinformation landscape surrounding the crisis and make well-informed decisions across various sectors.
